

Contractor Fraud

Just as with any business, unfortunately not all repair companies or contractors are trustworthy. Don't be a victim when it comes to home repairs. Here are some **red flags** to look out for. **IF a contractor...**

- Offers you by phone, mail or email a free inspection, or even a free gift card if you allow an inspection of your home or property. Remember, if it sounds too good to be true, it probably is.
- Promises to waive or provide a rebate for your insurance policy deductible amount.
- Rushes you to sign a contract, without first providing you with a copy and time to review.
- Requests full payment — or a cash payment — ahead of time or tells you their offer is available only for a limited time.

If you're feeling pressured or bullied to sign a contract or other form for repair work to start, **WAIT!** We recommend that you discuss with your insurance agent or insurance company before signing on the dotted line, to help protect your rights.

Best Practices For Repair Companies

Whether you're working with a CastleCare vendor or a contractor you've hired previously, the following best practices are recommended.

Work only with licensed, insured and bonded contractors. You can verify the contractor is licensed by Florida at Myfloridalicense.com. You have the right to request proof of insurance bonding, too.

Ask for references and check them out. Also, you can check with the **Better Business Bureau** at bbb.org to find out if others have had challenging experiences with them.

- **Get more than one estimate.**
 - **Get everything in writing: total cost; detailed list of what the project includes; time schedule; guarantees, and/or warranties provided; payment schedule; and never sign a contract that includes blanks.**
 - **Do not make a final payment or sign a completion form until you are fully satisfied with the work completed.**
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Read carefully what you are signing.

Don't be pushed into signing a contract right away. Importantly, never sign a contract that includes blanks. Be sure to keep a copy of any document you have signed.

Network Service Providers

Warranties

Completed projects qualify for CastleCare's Quality Assurance Program, which provides a five-year warranty on contractor workmanship and a one-year warranty on materials.

IMPORTANT: *If consulting with a repair company other than CastleCare, please do not authorize the contractor to begin significant repairs until the damage has been inspected by your insurance company.*
