

# Keep Your Pets Safe During a Storm



Help keep your pets safe during storm season by taking care of the following items before bad weather strikes.

## Identification

- ✓ Make sure pets are wearing a collar with updated identification tags, including your address and phone number.
- ✓ Include a copy of your pet's microchip number (if they have one) and a photo of your pet, along with other important documents, in your hurricane kit.

## Supplies

- ✓ Stock up on non-perishable food, plenty of water, and medications your pet may need, plus trash bags for clean up.
- ✓ If traveling, bring a sturdy, portable carrier large enough for your pet to sleep in, their favorite toy or blanket, and non-breakable food and water bowls.
- ✓ Include a litter box and extra kitty litter for cats.
- ✓ Be sure to have a strong collar and leash.

## Vaccinations and Records

- ✓ Make sure your pet's rabies tag and county license tag is current and worn on their collar.
- ✓ Have a copy of your pet's most recent vaccinations and medical records in case your pet needs to be boarded or treated by a different veterinarian.
