Help keep your pets safe during storm season by taking care of the following items before bad weather strikes.


## **Identification**



Make sure pets are wearing a collar with updated identification tags, including your address and phone number.

Include a copy of your pet's microchip number (if they have one) and a photo of your pet, along with other important documents, in your hurricane kit.

## **Supplies**





If traveling, bring a sturdy, portable carrier large enough for your pet to sleep in, their favorite toy or blanket, and non-breakable food and water bowls.



Include a litter box and extra kitty litter for cats.

Be sure to have a strong collar and leash.

## Vaccinations and Records



Have a copy of your pet's most recent vaccinations and medical records in case your pet needs to be boarded or treated by a different veterinarian.
